The mission of the Alderson Hospitality House is to provide support for those incarcerated of the Alderson Federal Prison Camp, their families and friends by providing temporary lodging, meals, transportation, emotional support and education.



The Alderson Hospitality House is

- ☞ A place of comfort for the families and friends visiting their loved ones at the prison camp. The staff is an integral part in providing that comfort by keeping the house clean and safe, providing healthy and delicious meals, and most importantly, maintaining a ministry of presence.
- ☞ A place of loving support. Guests who have stayed with us for a while feel like dear friends; families who are just beginning their journey through incarceration are often scared, lonely, frustrated, and need to talk. We are here to support them, to provide information, be a shoulder to cry on and a friend to laugh with.
- ☞ Located 3 minutes from the Federal Prison Camp Alderson, which is a minimum security federal prison facility for women. It houses approximately 1000 women.
- ☞ Located in the small town of Alderson, WV in rural Appalachia.
- ☞ Best described as a nonprofit bed and breakfast. There are 13 bedrooms, 5 bathrooms, one kitchen, two television/sitting rooms, and a park across the street where guests can enjoy the outdoors. We serve a continental breakfast Friday – Monday morning and dinner Friday – Sunday evening.
- ☞ At maximum sleeping capacity at 52 people, though on average weekend evenings we host around 40.
- ☞ An independent 501©3 nonprofit organization, which runs on donations from a variety of people and organizations and is not funded by any one individual church, organization, or governmental agency.
